

General Mounting Instructions: Side Seat Mounts



The above photo on the left is the underside of the front passenger's seat in a truck. We are looking at the inside edge on the seat mount from the factory. The next photo on the right shows the mount being placed into its location on the console side of the passenger's seat. The mount for the Chevy and Ford truck with bucket seats will use this type of mounting system.

The mount sets on the floor and has mounting bolts that will extend through the seat base mount to the underside of the base. Once there, you have a metal plate which will fit over the four bolts and locate the seat base between the out and inner mount. Once these bolts are tightened down, this will sandwich the seat base between the two plates and give you a solid mount for your computer.

You can add the top 9 or 12 arm assembly into this mount, since the pole is part of the base. After the top arm is installed, you can lock it into place with the handle. This will hold the unit and make it easier to install the tilt swivel and then the docking station.

This type of mount is made so you can move the passenger's seat back and forth and use the seat normally. Please note that the computer screen on your laptop should be in the closed position while the vehicle is in transit.
